

Triple Canopy Ranch

Rules

1. ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK!
2. No glass bottles.
3. No Dirt Bikes, 2 wheeled vehicles or 3 wheelers allowed.
4. ATV's must have flags mounted.
5. No illegal drugs.
6. No Firearms.
7. No Pets.
8. No Fireworks.
9. No Public Nudity.
10. No underage drinking. All state alcohol laws apply.
11. No chainsaws. No cutting or damaging of any trees or vegetation on the property.
12. Everyone entering Triple Canopy Ranch must sign a liability waiver prior to being admitted.
13. Wristbands must be worn throughout your entire stay at Triple Canopy Ranch. Anyone found without a wristband will be asked to leave the premises immediately and will be required to pay the entrance fee to re-enter.
14. All riding is at your own risk.
15. All Minors (under the age of 18) shall be supervised by their parent or adult guardian at all times.
16. Riding is allowed in mud pits during daylight hours only or as posted by the park.
17. All riding and vehicle traffic within the park to stop at 2:00 a.m. except for incoming traffic.
18. Quiet hours in all camping areas from 2:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.
19. All vehicles must remain within the boundaries of the park and avoid all restricted areas identified by orange fencing. Violators will be evicted!
20. Campfires must be placed in a container or hole and must be attended at all times. No burning of pallets or tires allowed.

Guests who disregard the rules of Triple Canopy Ranch or pose a safety threat to themselves or other Guests will be subject to ejection from the premises without a refund.
